- The School City of Mishawaka Board of Trustees approved a recommendation from the Superintendent to have each elementary school develop a schedule and program whereby 5th and 6th grade students can experience a better, more effective, transition to the middle school. Specifically, these “transition plans” will involve 5th and 6th graders having more than one teacher during their school day. At Beiger, plans are underway to accommodate this district initiative. The plan will be put in place for this next 2018-19 school year. Students will be assigned to a “homerom” teacher, but they will also have the other teachers – primarily in the areas of math, English, and language arts. Teachers are working to divide and map the curriculum to better target student instruction and we believe there will be many positive outcomes.
- As we conclude this school year there are many special events and activities so be sure to review the end of year school calendar! It has been a great privilege and honor to serve as the Beiger principal these past few years. I have enjoyed working with great students and supportive parents. I would also like to thank so many of you who have sent “retirement” cards and notes – I sincerely appreciate it!
