PURPOSE

Mishawaka High School, in partnership with the community, will graduate students who are academically and socially prepared and capable of adapting in a dynamic society.

GOALS

As part of the accreditation process of continuous school improvement a school identifies specific goals to work towards during an accreditation cycle. The current goals at MHS are:

- Students will improve their reading and writing skills across the curriculum.
- Students will improve their mathematics skills across the curriculum.

Accreditation visit occurs this school year, March 23 and 24, 2016.

STRATEGIES

- All teachers incorporate reading, writing, and math in their content area classes.
- All teachers expect all students to write in complete sentences.
- All teachers encourage and model mathematical thinking and problem solving.
- All teachers and students participate in a Sustained Silent Reading (SSR) program in Advisory on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- MHS's SSR program includes a short discussion component on Mondays and a short writing component on Wednesdays.
